### SUNDAY

#### FOUNDATIONS OF THE CHRISTIAN FAITH

9:30AM-10:15AM

A gospel centered question and answer class that summarizes important Christian beliefs to enable transformation through the knowledge of scripture. This ministry is broken out into three 6-7 weeks sections offered throughout the year.

#### PRESERVICE COFFEE HOUR

10:30AM-11AM

Each Sunday we gather for coffee and conversation before our Worship Service.

#### WORSHIP SERVICE

11AM-12PM

On Sunday, we worship together with traditional and newer hymns/songs and instruments, a message from God's Word, prayers for each other and our community. On the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of each month, we share the Lord's Supper (communion) together.

#### LUNCH OR SNACK FELLOWSHIP

12PM-1PM

Each Sunday, the worship service is followed by lunch (1<sup>st</sup> Sunday) or snack fellowship the rest of the month.

### WEDNESDAY

#### ACTS 2:42 COMMUNITY

6PM-7:30PM

Our Acts 2:42 Community is a ministry where people of all ages worship, learn, share a meal and fellowship together.

### 3<sup>RD</sup> FRIDAY

6PM-7:30PM

On most 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday of the month, we have community social events such as an open mic night, a game night, "Bingo and Singo" (no cost games of Bingo with music and snacks), etc.

### WEEKLY BIBLE STUDIES

Throughout the year, we plan time limited biblical studies during the mornings, afternoon, and evenings on specific topics or studying through books of the Bible.

### COMPASS MINISTRIES

This area of ministry aims to provide time limited educational groups regarding finances, family, parenting, recovery, grief and loss, and other health and wellness areas as needed.

### ARLINGTONVILLE CHILDREN

#### FIRST STEPS

Kids aged to 6 years old start classroom # 4 at 11am where they listen to music, play, color and hear Bible stories.

The First Steps Room is open at 10:50am and the children are signed in by a parent or someone designated by a parent in writing. First Step kids are again picked up by the same person immediately after service.

## **ARLINGTON KIDS**

Kids aged 6 to 12 years old start and stay in the sanctuary where they worship and hear a Children's Message using the Bible-based Sermons4Kids Curriculum during service. After the Children's Message they work through fun and informative age-related activity books (5-8 and 9-12) or use their drawing pads to draw what they hear during the sermon. All kids take home a Sermons4Kids Worship Bulletin related to the day's lesson to complete at home.

## **YOUTH**

Youth aged 12 and up participate in service ministries; handing out bulletins, serving with the worship team, reading scriptures, etc. or assist in the First Step classroom. They also can work through a teen faith-based activity book or their drawing pad.

## **COMMUNITY MINISTRIES**

### **A S MAY SCHOOL SUPPLIES**

Every August we collect school supplies to donate to the elementary school in our community. This helps families that find it difficult to purchase the supplies their children need at the beginning of the school year.

### **LOVE, INC**

In February we collect personal care items or requested items for Mid-Hudson Love INC, which is a partnership of churches who serve people in need to build relationships, restore hope, and transform lives.

### **MHA VETERANS PROGRAM**

In November we collect requested food items to donate to the Veterans One Stop Program in Pleasant Valley who serve Vets in need.
