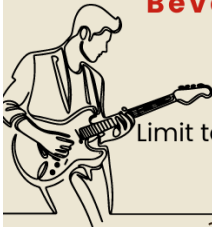

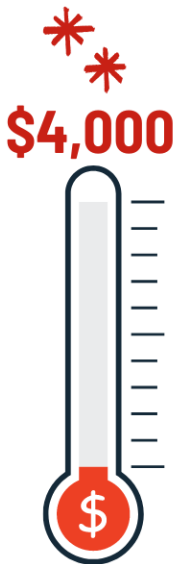

## RESPONDING TO GOD

Lord's Supper

*E = Elder C = Congregation*

E: Beloved in the Lord Jesus, the meal which we are about to celebrate is a feast of remembrance, communion, and hope.

**C: We come to remember that Jesus was sent into the world to take on flesh and blood, to become God with us, that we might be redeemed.**

E: We come to have communion with this same Christ who has promised to be with us even to the end of the world.

**C: We come in hope, believing that this bread and this cup are a pledge and a foretaste of a new heaven and a new earth, where we shall behold God.**

E: Jesus said, I was hungry and you gave me food;

**C: I was thirsty and you gave me drink.**

E: Here is the bread of life given for us;

**C: let all who hunger come and eat.**

E: Here is the fruit of the vine, poured out for us;

**C: let all who thirst come and drink.**

E: The Lord be with you.

**C: And also with you.**

E: Lift up your hearts!

**C: We lift them up to the Lord.**

E: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

**C: It is right to give our thanks and praise!**

E: Holy and right it is to give you thanks and praise at all times and in all places, God our Creator, source of all life and goodness, You created heaven with all its hosts and the earth with all its plenty and preserve us by your providence.

**C: When we disobeyed, you sent Jesus to deliver us from sin and death and free us to joyful obedience.**

E: Most righteous God, we remember in this meal the perfect sacrifice offered once on the cross by our Lord Jesus Christ for the sin of the whole world.

**C: United with Christ in his suffering, strengthened by the Holy Spirit, trusting in the power of God to triumph over evil, we wait in joyful hope for the fullness of God's reign.**

E: We pray that the bread which we break and the cup which we bless may be to us the communion of the body and blood of Christ. Grant that, being joined together in him, we may attain to the unity of the faith and grow up in all things into Christ our Lord.

**C: And as this grain has been gathered from many fields into one loaf, and these grapes from many hills into one cup, grant, O Lord, that your whole Church may soon be gathered from the ends of the earth into your kingdom. Even so, come, Lord Jesus!**

E: The Lord Jesus, the same night he was betrayed, took bread; and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you: do this in remembrance of me."

After the same manner also, he took the cup when they had supped, saying, "This cup is the New Testament in my blood: this do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."

The bread which we break is the communion of the body of Christ (*take the bread together*).

The cup of blessing which we bless is the communion of the blood of Christ (*drink the cup together*).
