FOUNDATIONS

Scripture

The Word of God is central to our worship. We don't gather to hear an inspirational talk. We gather for worship to hear from God through Scripture.

All the specific elements of our worship service—things like prayers, Scripture readings, The Lord's Supper, and songs—find their place within scripture.

Worship

Worship is at the center of the church's life. In worship, we acknowledge God's worth. That worship encompasses the whole week—when we are out in the community, in our homes, or gathered together. Because Christians are all members of the one body of Christ, we make it a priority to come together to worship as one.

Belonging

As Christians, we primarily belong—body and soul, in life and in death—to our faithful savior, Jesus Christ (Heidelberg Catechism, Q&A 1). Believers mature when they belong to a local church, a community of faith where they worship, take part in the sacraments of the Lord's Supper and baptism, hear God's Word, and use their gifts, talents and abilities to serve each other and their neighbors.

The Arlington Community Church seeks to glorify God by preaching the gospel and making disciples who worship God, obey Christ's commands, and grow to maturity through loving God and loving others.
